

Instructions for Poster Presentations for ICMM2021

Thank you for presenting a poster at ICMM2021. The poster session will be very different to a normal poster session, and we therefore want to guide you so you can give the best possible poster.

1. Please prepare your poster in **landscape** orientation. The audience will be viewing on computer screens which display better in landscape.
2. The largest computer screens are **far smaller** than a normal poster. Therefore, the **amount of material on the poster should be far less**.
3. Please think carefully about font sizes and the size of images. Small images and small text will not be legible.
4. Please save your poster as PDF.
5. We need your poster by Thursday June 10th at 5 pm UK time. This is so we can share the posters with the poster hosts. We aim to have the posters on-line throughout the conference. **Please send posters to icmm2020@manchester.ac.uk with subject "POSTER #" where # is your unique submission ID.**
6. The poster session will take place in breakout rooms within a Zoom link. There will be a poster host who will help you during the session. Your poster will be presented for a 25 minute slot. Current poster programme can be found online [HERE](#). During your slot you will be asked questions. If the questions are continuing at the 25 minute mark we will suggest you and your questioner exchange e-mail addresses to continue the discussion.
7. There will be two poster prizes for each of the three poster sessions.
